Our lives often are shaped by an awareness of time. The theme of this exhibit is time; the presence, contraction, expansion, duration and flow of time. These four artists were challenged to consider what is the meaning of time for them.

Ms. Azzara is an encaustic artist who paints with wax on panels. Her often quiet and spare works speak of landscapes and at times make us aware that we are alone. She has taught encaustics at the Newark Museum and elsewhere. She exhibits throughout the East Coast.

Ms. Trent uses found objects and the natural world to build and paint assemblages that appear to be meditative landscapes. She brings the viewer closer to her constructions with color, texture, objects and forms we recognize and remember. She shows throughout New Jersey.

Ms. Streicher paints in oil. She brings a distinct architectural voice to her paintings in which she creates surreal spaces. These spaces lead us on a journey to make sense of the elements, bringing us confusion, surprise and delight. She shows throughout the metropolitan area.

Ms. Winbury's abstract oils have a gestural and rhythmic quality set against a quiet minimalism. Her language evokes emotions both earthly and ephemeral. In June, she was a Bau Institute fellow in Italy and completed a 2014 residency at the School of Visual Arts, Manhattan. She shows throughout the east coast.
